

# LIQUID RELEASE AGENT

## PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Permacolour Liquid Release Agent is a parting agent used to keep texturing mats from stcking to the still plastic concrete. It also prolongs the life of the texturing mat by decreasing the friction between the texturing mat and the concrete. It forms a lubricating and parting barrier separating the concrete from the texturing mat.

## **APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS**

Using a pump type sprayer, apply a mist of Permacolour Clear Liquid Release onto the Imprinting Mats that you are going to use to keep them lubricated. Re-apply as necessary. When spraying on a surface that is going to be Imprinted, only mist the concrete surface. Do not over apply as this can cause a stippling effect on the imprinted surface. Using a pump type sprayer, apply a mist of Permacolour Clear Liquid Release on the coloured concrete where you are going to place the next few stamping mats. Do not apply over an area of more than three or four square metres as the Permacolour Liquid Release may evaporate before the mats are placed over it. At this stage when you lift the mats you may apply a coloured liquid release agent to achieve a quality antiquing effect. Mist newly imprinted area with desired colour then use the trowel as if using a squeegee, pull trowel across surface to drag excess coloured release agent from high points to low area's. This technique gives best results with little or no smudging. Alternatively on larger areas imprint with clear liquid release agent and colour wash the following day. To maintain the integrity of the Colour Hardened surface, do not trowel, or, in any way, mix the Permacolour Liquid Release with the surface. To make corrections on the still plastic concrete, use the texturing tool or skins and press out the unwanted impression.

## **COVERAGE**

Permacolour Liquid Release covers approximately 10-12m2 per litre.

#### **PACKAGING**

5 & 20 litre packs.

# **SEALING**

Once the concrete surface is dry & hard enough to walk on, a coat of Permacolour Sealer Primer can be applied. Permacolour Sealer Primer can be applied immediately over the Perma-Colour Liquid Release. No removal of the Liquid Release is necessary. When stamping is completed, wash off the Perma-colour Liquid Release from the texturing mats using concrete cleaner with water. Leave for 5-7 days then seal with Permacolour Concrete sealer.
